Microsoft Windows Server 2008 R2

Our April program is about Microsoft's Windows Server 2008 R2. Our speaker will be Matt Hester who is a US IT Pro Evangelist for Microsoft.

Matt will discuss the new features in Windows Server 2008 R2 with a focus on the benefits for IT Administrators. This session will cover many new features included in Windows Server 2008 R2 that improve the cost of ownership and IT administrator improvements. The session will cover the Best Practice Analyzer (BPA), Active Directory, Windows PowerShell, Power Management, Group Policy enhancements, Scalability, Server Core enhancements, Windows Server Web application platform, and new Remote Desktop Services features and capabilities.

Matt Hester is a seasoned Information Technology Professional Evangelist for Microsoft. Matt has been involved in the IT

Pro community for over 15 years. Matt is a skilled and experienced evangelist presenting to audiences nationally and internationally. Prior to joining Microsoft, Matt was a successful Microsoft Certified Trainer for over 8 years. After joining Microsoft, Matt has continued to be heavily involved in IT Pro Community as an IT Pro Evangelist. In his role at



Microsoft, Matt has presented to audiences in excess of 5,000 and as small as 10. Matt has also published 4 articles for TechNet magazine and runs a successful blog with ~350K touches a

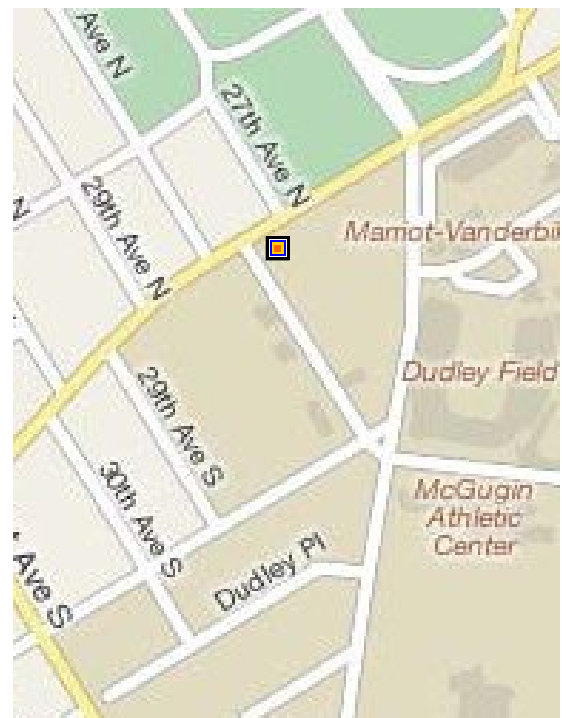
Since the Chapter pays for reserved meals, No Shows will be billed at the reservation price of \$20.00 for Members, and \$30.00 for Guests.

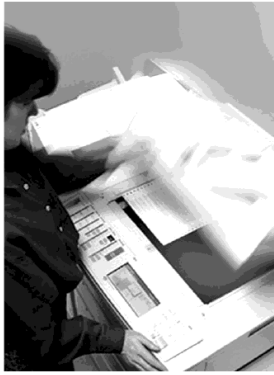
